Remember to protect all surfaces!

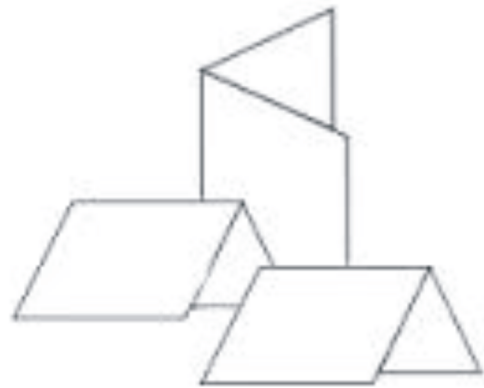


Step 1

Place a few dots of paint on the blank cards.

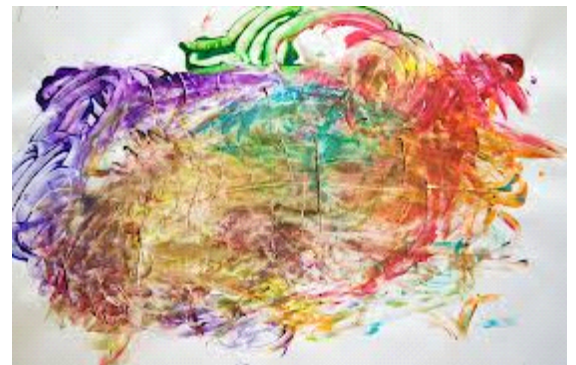
Step 2

Ask your child to smudge the dots.



Step 3

You can use these creations as greeting cards or thank you notes or for some special wrapping paper you can do this activity on brown paper.



Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

The EYFS sets standards for the learning, development and care of children from birth to 5 years old. It promotes teaching and learning through play to make sure all children have the skills they need for future life. There are 3 Prime Areas of Learning and 5 Specific Areas.
