Just you and your baby

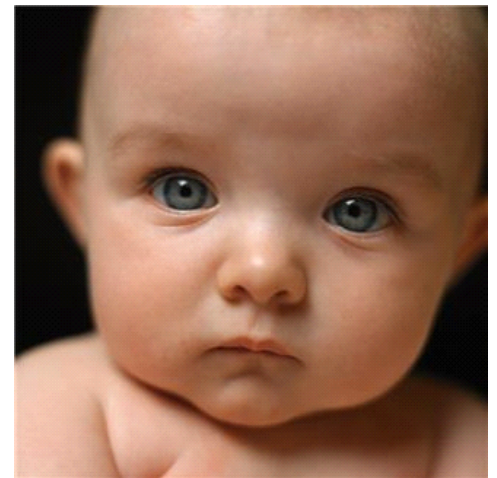


Step 1

When your child is in a settled mood try and get them to look at your face. Position yourself at their eye level so they can see your face clearly.

Step 2

Pull some funny faces and see if they try to copy you. Make an O shape with your mouth, open your eyes wide, scrunch your nose etc. Give lots of praise if they manage to copy any of your expressions.



Step 3

Then touch your nose and see if they copy. Move your body around blink then encourage them to copy. Keep a note of how they do
